Admission's Policy

This school admits students of any race, color, and national and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to the students at this school. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, color and national and ethnic origin in administration of its educational policies, admissions policies, financial aide, athletics, and other school-administered programs.

Placement: Grade placement for all students will be determined by the administrative staff.

Acceptance: Acceptance is based on a decision by the admissions committee. ETERNITY CHRISTIAN SCHOOL RESERVES THE RIGHT TO ADJUST AND\OR MODIFY COURSE SELECTIONS AND\OR COMBINATION OF CLASSES AT EACH GRADE LEVEL BASED ON FINAL ENROLLMENT. Acceptance is probational for the first quarter in academics and behavior performance. A parent conference at the end of the first nine weeks will review the academic progress and behavior progress of all new students.

Steps to Admission

For Students entering Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten: (Must be age 3 and 4 for Pre-Kindergarten and five for Kindergarten by September 1st) (Students whose birthday is in September may take a test to start school early)

- 1. Complete the application and forms and return them to the office with the following:
 - a. Copy of the birth certificate
 - Copy of all immunization information. (The health record must show student is current on all immunization.)
 - c. Copies of reports from previous special testing for reading or learning difficulties.
 - d. Non-refundable application fee.
- 2. After application fee is accepted, an interview will be required.
 - 3. The Admissions committee will make a decision on the applicant after the interview and notify the parents by letter.
 - 4. After acceptance, all fees must be paid according to the contract.

For Students Entering First through Eighth:

- 1. Complete the application and forms and return them to the office with the following:
 - a. Copy of the birth certificate (Must be six by September 1st)
 - b. Copy of all immunization information. (The health record must show student is current on all immunization.)
 - c. Copies of reports from previous special testing for reading or learning difficulties.
 - d. Copies of most recent report card, copies of past achievement tests.
 - e. Non-refundable application fee.
- 2. After application fee is accepted, each student must have taken an achievement test in the spring or an individual achievement testing will be arranged before applicant can be interviewed. (Parent's Fee for testing is \$25.00)
- 3. Following the testing an interview will be required.
- 4. The Admissions committee will make a decision on the applicant after the interview and notify the parents by letter.
- 5. After acceptance, all fees must be paid according to the contract.

Admission Procedures and Requirements

The following steps indicate the procedure followed for admitting students to Eternity Christian School:

- 1. When parents make an inquiry, they are invited to visit the school personally and make an appointment for an interview.
- During the interview, the discussion will center on the structure of the school, the educational philosophy, spiritual program, grading methods, etc., and will usually involve a tour of the facilities. Both parents and students are to be present for the interview.
- 3. When necessary forms are to be completed, both parents must sign the forms and the registration fee paid. This will hold your child's place in class.
- 4. It may be necessary for some children to take the Stanford Achievement Test before admission is granted. There will be a \$40.00 testing fee whether or not the student is accepted.
- 5. It may be necessary to have approval from the administrator before the child is admitted.
- 6. It is the requirement of the school that at least one parent or guardian be a "born-again or saved" Christian parent or guardian and that both the parents or guardian and child want to live the Christian life and attend church services regularly.

ALL Grade Level and Pre-Kindergarten Additional Fees:

- Enrollment Fee: Pre-Kindergarten enrollment Fee \$-0-; Kindergarten-10th grade \$50.00 These fees are non-refundable.
- ♦ General Fee: The general fee covers the cost of rental of textbooks (to be returned at the end of the school year or upon withdrawal), accident insurance, lab fees, teaching supplies, classroom equipment, playground equipment, and library. These fees are \$120 for Pre-Kindergarten. These fees are non-refundable.
- Other Costs: There may be a cost for field trips, Vision/Hearing Testing, Stanford Achievement Test, and others that would be incurred as events and circumstances arise.
- ◆ Thirty-eight (38) Weekly payments fee has an additional accounting fee and includes the general fees.

Financial and Enrollment Agreement

Acceptance to Eternity Christian School is granted based on the agreement by parents to pay their tuition according to the agreed upon tuition schedule and payment plan. Eternity Christian School depends upon every family paying their tuition on time so that the educational program of all students can continue as planned.

By making application to Eternity Christian School parents agree to the following financial conditions:

- 1. I understand that enrollment fees and general fees are non-refundable and that the enrollment fee will hold my child's class placement and the general fee will be paid by the first day of school or may be paid in two payments half by the first day of school and the other half on or before September 15th. All textbooks must be returned in good condition at the end of the school term or upon withdrawal. I will pay the replacement cost of any books not returned in non-usable condition.
- 2. I understand that withdrawals after the first school day of the current semester that I will be charged the entire current semester's tuition. I understand that if I select a payment plan and change my plan at any time, I will be charged a \$20 processing fee and may also have to pay a \$25 late payment fee. I understand that all withdrawals, whether before the school year begins or during the school year, must be made in writing and shall be effective when such notice is delivered to the school. I understand that I will still be held responsible for the financial obligation. Parents are expected to meet with the principal before proceeding with withdrawal.
- 3. I understand that all accounts must be current for grade cards and transcripts to be issued. School records will be forwarded to another school only when an account is current. I understand that only those students whose accounts are current will be permitted to participate in special activities requiring additional expense; for example, programs, field trip.
- 4. For the monthly payment plan, the school will accept cash, money orders, and Master Card/Visa (with an additional fee). All payments received on a weekly payment plan must be in cash, cashier's check, money orders, and Master Card/Visa (with an additional fee). A late payment fee of \$25 will be charged for any payment received after the 5th of the month and a \$20.00 late fee after Monday for weekly payments. For monthly payment plans, I agree that my account must be current by the 5th of the month in order for my child (ren) to remain in school. For weekly payment plans, I agree that my account must be current by the Wednesday of that week's payment for my child(ren) to remain in school. I agree to withdraw my child (ren) if I am unable to pay my tuition on time. I may enroll my child(ren) once my account is current and not have to pay a re-enrollment fee providing re-enrollment is for the current school year.
- 5. Since fund raising is essential to keep tuition low as possible, I agree to whole-heartedly support Eternity's two-four major fund raising projects by being actively involved—children and parents.
- 6. I agree to release Eternity Christian School and its representatives from liability in the event of accident or injury.
- 7. I/we understand that my/our child's likeness may be photographed or videotaped by the school in the course of school activities. I/we hereby give consent for the school to use my/our child's likeness photograph or videotape in promotional and/or advertising materials. I agree that I have read and am in agreements with the Student/Parent Handbook which also contains the FERPA Law and the school's technology policy.
- 8. School/Family Cooperation. A positive and constructive relationship between the School and Family Member (defined as Parent, Student, or other person associated with Student) is essential to the School's educational purpose and responsibilities to its students. If any Family Member engages in behavior, communications, or interactions on or off campus, that is disruptive, intimidating, overly aggressive, or reflects a loss of confidence in or disagreement with the School's policies, methods of instruction or discipline, or otherwise interferes with the School's safety procedures, responsibilities, or accomplishment of its educational purpose or program, the School reserves the right to dismiss the Family or Family Member from the community. The School may also place restrictions on a Family Member's involvement or activity at School for other reasons that the School deems appropriate. Any determination under this Paragraph shall be in the School's sole discretion. There will be no refund of tuition where such dismissal occurs and any unpaid balance is payable in full according to the terms of this Contract. The School also reserves the right to withdraw an offer of enrollment or re-enrollment at any time and to void an executed Enrollment Contract. I agree that the parties of this agreement are Christians and believe that the Bible commands them to make every effort to resolve disputes in private following Matthew 18 principle. If a dispute cannot be resolved, the parties agree to seek mediation and if necessary, arbitration, in a Christian manner using a Christian mediation and arbitration organization.
- 9. The Children's Online Privacy Protection Act of 1998 ("COPPA") requires that website operators acquire parental permission before collecting personal information from a child under the age of 13. While this law does not apply to non-profit institutions such as Eternity Christian School, it may apply to the operators of some external third-party online services utilized by the School. By accepting admission to Eternity Christian School, I give the school consent to provide personal identifying information for my student consisting of first name, last name, email address and username to third-party online services utilized by the School to access information, collaborate, create and communicate in connection with learning activities. Services may include: Microsoft Office 365 Pro Plus for Education, Canvas by Instructure, IXL, Follett, OverDrive, LibGuides, and other educationally appropriate third-party services the School may add at its discretion. This consent will remain in effect until the student turns 13 years of age, or until the student is no longer enrolled at the School. I understand that I may withdraw my permission at any time with written notice to the School and I can learn more about COPPA at http://coppa.org.
- 10. I acknowledge that Eternity Christian School, INC. will not be legally liable or responsible for any delay or failure of its performance under this Agreement, including any changes in programming, cancellation or other alteration, resulting from an Act of God or other condition beyond its control (force majeure), including but not limited to fire or other natural disaster, war, violence or terrorism or other major event. In such a case, Eternity Christian School will suspend or alter its performance if and until, in its sole discretion, it is able to appropriately resume performance.
- 11. In accepting admission to Eternity Christian School, I, on behalf of my student, accept the Eternity Christian School "Technology Use Policy" in its entirety. This policy is located in the Student and Parent Handbook.

By signing below, I certify and represent that I am the student's legally authorized parent, and that I have the legal authority to enroll my child in Eternity Christian School, to permit my child to participate in all activities, and to execute this Agreement and all other required documents for myself and for and on behalf of my participating child. To the extent necessary, I agree that I have obtained any and all other pertinent consents or authorities (including any required by a court decree or order; for example, a divorce decree, custody order or joint parenting plan). I fully understand and agree that if my child's other parent (or anyone else) challenges my authority: a) the child will be dismissed from Eternity Christian School or any activities, without a refund, if the parents or other parties involved cannot reach agreement, and b) I will fully defend and indemnify Eternity Christian School (and other Released Parties) with Acknowledgment and Assumption of Risks & Release and Indemnity Agree mentor otherwise, including payment of any costs or attorneys' fees expended by Eternity Christian School to resolve a dispute. By placing my signature to this document, I understand and am in agreement with the conditions stated above and the Student/Parent Policy manual which I have received a copy. Eternity Christian School Annual Field Trip Release/Emergency Medical Forms

This form will be on file at the school office for the current school year. An additional Permission to Participate form will be sent home to each off-campus trip. I give permission for ________, date of birth _________, grade _________, to participate in all sports and school-sponsored trips away from the school premises throughout the current school year. Students will be accompanied by a teacher and will be under adequate supervision. I understand that I will be given at least 48 hours notice of all trips away from the school premises. I further understand that I may revoke permission for a specific field trip by written notice hand delivered to the principal more than one day prior to the trip. Although the school desires to provide a safe and enjoyable time for all students, accidents can still happen. I/we understand that there are risks/dangers involved with participation in off-campus trips and their associated activities. I/we agree to hold harmless Eternity Christian School, its affiliated organizations, employees, agents, and representatives, including volunteer and other drivers, from any and all claims arising from my child's participation. This release agreement does not apply to claims of intentional (criminal) misconduct or gross negligence by the school, its employees, or volunteers. If such circumstances are proved in a court of law, I/we acknowledge and agree that the school can assume no financial liability beyond its actual liability insurance policy in force. In case of accident, illness, or other emergency, I/we request that the school give the student first-aide and then contact me . If the school cannot reach a parent/guardian after conscientious effort, I/we give permission for school staff to call paramedics or any licensed physician or dentist. If a life-threatening emergency exists, I/we give permission for school staff to call paramedics or any licensed physician or dentist. sion for school staff to immediately call paramedics and then contact me/us as soon as possible thereafter. The student will be taken to Houston Northwest Medical Center Emergency Room or the hospital of your choice. Eternity Christian School does not assume responsibility for the payment of hospital, doctor, or ambulance fees. I/we agree to allow the school to give any of the over-the-counter medications. Uniform Dress Code

The Bible does tell us that man looks at a person's outer appearance, but God looks at our hearts (I Samuel 16:7). We know that how we are viewed by God is the most important thing! Nevertheless, man does look at our outward appearance. Even as we have an obligation to see that our hearts are clean and pleasing to God, we also have an obligation to see that our appearance is clean and pleasing to man. There is a close relationship between performance and appearance. It is our belief that students will achieve and develop their potential in proportion to how they view themselves. In accordance with this underlying belief, we at Eternity Christian School expect the students to observe the guidelines presented for young men and women. It is the school's belief that parents will accept their responsibility and students will show their respect for the school by living within the guidelines expressed below. The administration and teachers of Eternity Christian School will maintain and enforce the dress code at both school and school related functions.

ELEMENTARY Pre-Kindergarten thru 8th Grade: Girls:

BLOUSE - Solid white tucked, long or short sleeve.

SHIRTS - Polo yellow, white, green, burgundy, light blue, navy, pink, orange, or red. Short or long sleeve.

JUMPER - Navy.

LEGGINGS: Black, White, or Navy

SLACKS - Navy, khaki, or black.

SHORTS/SKORTS - Navy, khaki, or black. Knee length. (Grades PK age 3 thru 3th grade only)

SWEATER - Navy, white, or red pullover v-neck, vest or cardigan. SOCKS - Knee-highs, anklets or tights of any solid color that coordinates with uniform colors.

SHOES - Solid navy, black, white dress shoe or black/white saddle. Tennis shoes are acceptable. **No sandals, jelly shoes, or cowboy boots.**

JEWELRY - No more than two delicate chains, two small bracelets, or two rings are allowed. One pair of earrings.

CHAPEL DRESS(WEDNESDAY) - Navy jumper K - 4th, or navy skirt (for 5-7th grade only). Jumper and skirt length must cover the entire knee cap. (The bottom of the knee). White blouse with jumper or skirt.

FRIDAY'S DRESS: Jeans pants or capris and

School T-Shirt (Jean shorts may be worn by PK age 3 thru 3rd grade only and must be knee length)

ELEMENTARY Pre-Kindergarten thru 8th Grade: Boys:

DRESS SHIRTS - Solid White tucked.

SHIRTS - Polo white, red, navy, light blue, green, burgundy, orange, or yellow. Long or short sleeve.

TROUSERS - Navy, black, or khaki.

SHORTS - Navy, black, or khaki. (Grades PK age 3 thru 3rd grade)

SWEATER - Navy, white, or red, v-neck pullover, vest, or cardigan.

TIE - Any style tie.

BELTS - Solid navy, black or brown. Must be worn at all times. Decorative buckles or cowboy belts are not authorized.

SOCKS - Full length, solid navy, black, brown or grey worn at all times. White socks with tennis shoes only.

SHOES - Cordovan, brown, black, navy oxford or loafer. Tennis shoe. Grey, brown, navy, one color docksiders are also acceptable. Cowboy boots and sandals are not permitted.

JEWELRY - Watch only, one ring, one bracelet and one necklace.

CHAPEL DRESS(WEDNESDAY) - Navy slacks and solid white dress shirt with tie.

FRIDAY'S DRESS: Jeans pants and School T-Shirt (Jean shorts may be worn by PK age 3 thru 3rd grade only and must be knee length)

- 1. Hair for elementary and secondary boys must be clean, groomed neatly and blocked straight across the back and off the collar and covering no more than 1\2 of the ear. The curly-bush look on the sides or back of the head is not permitted. The new wave or punk look are not acceptable or any "out of the ordinary" hair fashion.
- 2. All personal items must be marked with student name and grade. Hats or caps are to be worn outside of the building only. (Includes athletic caps)
- 3. Outer wear such as jackets and coats are not be worn in the classroom. We encourage parents to monitor students to see that students dress appropriately for the various seasons. Denim jackets/coats are not acceptable on campus and should not be worn to school.
- 4. All students, while on campus, are expected to be in dress code. All shirts and blouses are to be buttoned correctly and tucked in at all times. This includes t-shirts under clothing. Shirts Short sleeved shirts are not to be rolled up. Slacks and trousers are to be worn comfortably and loosely, but not in a sloppy manner (pant legs or blazer sleeves may not be rolled up).
- 5. Shoelaces: It is expected that our students will be good examples of neatness; therefore, it is expected that students who wear lace shoes or tennis shoes will have them laced and tied.
