## Monday's Folders:

## Change of Clothes:

Please send a winter change of clothes for your child. There are many times when your child might need their extra set of clothes. If anyone has the school's extra clothes, please return them. We use them when children have accidents and need new clothes. Thanks!

## Vacation and Sick Tuition Payments:

Your child will only be allowed one free week of vacation per calendar year and it will be half-tuition on weeks that your child is out sick for the whole week. All vacation weeks should be in writing prior to taking the vacation week and a sick week will need a doctor's note. Otherwise tuition is paid by the week as normal. ## Holiday Tuition Payments:

If your child was out for the Christmas Holidays (Dec. 25-Jan. 5), you will need to pay \$63.00 per child for each week your child was out.

**Potty Training Class: (All 2 year olds)** Please **do not** bring pull ups for your child until Mrs. Beth has sent you a **notice** that your child needs them. We have an age limit on potty training and a class size limit. We will only accept Velcro Pull Ups for those that are potty training.

## SICKNESS:

*If your child is running a fever of 100 F or more we will not be able to take them. If your child has green mucus from the nose, we will not be able to take them.*

*I am sure that you do not want your child in a class with a sick child, so please do not send your child to school sick. We want to keep our children well.*
